When Handwritten：

A byphen instead of a decimal point should be used on all haoderitten cheques．This is to reduce the possibility of error and fraudulent alterntion．For amounts under fI there must alvays be a nought before the hyphen（or decimal point where printed or ryped），e．g．，$(0-37$ ．For amounts of $\ell 1$ and over these must always be two figures（ooughts if necessary）after the hyphen（or decimal point），e．g．，f． $1-00$〔 $15-78\{15-80$ ．

## Amoual』 in Word』

For amounts under $\mathcal{C} 1$ the term＇pence＇is uned instead of＇new pence＇．Cheques drawn on and after D－ Day can only be draven in decima currency and therefore old peace can never be intended．For amounts over $\{1$ where new pence are included they ate to be shown as figurea，as above there muss always be two figuren，e．g．Seven pounds 65 Three pounds 07 Twenry pounds 20.
