







Heading for HERE. The little bridge you see which allows one to walk from Dock 1 to Dock 6 in normal times is part of a device called a Caisson which stops the sea getting into Basin No1. You will see another Caisson at the back 0 Berth of HMS Victory with a walk-way, Berth stopping the water from Basin No1 Lock 0 getting into Victory's dock.
