I then received a request from the sweeping deck to top engines. The orepesa was then brought inboard, and the wire unsnackies. I then proceeded aft and observed a dark vect in the otter, have orders to clear the sweeping deck and sturned to the oridge. The signalman was then instructed to report the position the Senior Officer. My intention was then to proceed slow shead, veer sweep if the obstruction was a mine, to explode it on the bottom, in any case cut the sweep when sufficient wire had been ered for safety. It was at this moment, 1632, a very heavy explosion courred, and I immediately proceeded aft to investigate and ound there were no casualties. From the first investigation actual damage could be observed in the null, the rudder was bent and out of action. A report was sent to the Senior flicer by V/S.

At 1800 the ship was taken in tow by 'Mangrove'. At the water had reached to wardroom level, and the Senior fficer was informed.

At 2040 the tow parted. At 2051 'Almond' came ongside with instructions to take off everybody. This operation completed by 2110. At 2115 'Aercury' sank.

A short time later, whilst "Almond" was still alongside, I ordered every-


