# **FUNERAL OF LT CDR IAN MOLYNEUX RN – C038253J**

Can I start by saying what a wonderful response to the notice posted on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> April. A true submariner's reaction, justifiably confirming our ethos. I now have an update on the proceedings:

- 1. **Background.** Lt Cdr Molyneux, the WEO of HMS ASTUTE, was killed onboard, alongside in Southampton on 8 Apr 11. The Molyneux family has opted for a Service Funeral.
- 2. Lt Cdr Molyneux leaves a large, closely knit family. The family consists of his wife Gillian and their four children Jamie (13), Arron (12), Bethany (6) and Charlie (3).

#### **FUNERAL LOCATION AND TIMINGS**

3. The funeral will take place at the Sacred Heart Church, Springfield Rd, Wigan, WN6 7AT, followed by a burial at Gidlow Cemetery, Wigan Rd, Standish, Wigan, WN6 0AD. The family has invited Royal Navy personnel to the Requiem Mass, the burial and Wake.

### **CHAPLAIN**

4. Chaplain Andrew McFadden Royal Navy (FASFLOT) and Father Andrew Jolly from the Sacred Heart Church will conduct the service.

### **CONDUCT OF FUNERAL**

- 5. **Arrival of the Funeral Cortege.** The funeral cortege will arrive at the church and be met by the bearer party. After a short pause, the bearer party will carry the coffin of the late Lt Cdr Molyneux into the church, preceding the immediate family members. The bearer party will position the coffin and family members/bearer party will then be seated.
- 6. **The Church Service.** The Requiem Mass will be conducted by Chaplain Andrew McFadden and Father Andrew Jolly, lasting approximately 80 minutes. On completion of the service the bearer party will carry the coffin out of the church, followed by the immediate family, naval representatives and the congregation. The Funeral Officer will initiate the salute as the hearse leaves for the cemetery.
- 7. **Arrangements at the Cemetery.** Once the bearer party has placed the coffin in the hearse they will travel directly to Gidlow cemetery ahead of the funeral cortege. The Bugler will already be in position for the committal where the Last Post and Reveille will be sounded. On commencement of the committal the Last post will be sounded. After a period of silence the Reveille will be sounded. On completion of the Graveside Service, Royal Navy personnel Standards and SA Members are invited to depart the area, at the request of the family.

8. Main timings.

Serial	Time	Event
1	1155	Hearse arrives at church. Bearer party and coffin precede family.
2	1200	Requiem Mass.
3	1320	On completion of Requiem Mass, Bearer party moves the coffin to the hearse. Family following.
4	o/c	FO initiates salute as hearse departs for cemetery. Bearer party transported to cemetery.
5	o/c	Mini bus picks up Standard Bearers. (TBC. Depending on availability from HMS Eaglet.)
6	1400	Committal conducted by Chaplain McFadden. Bugler: Last Post and Reveille.
7	1500 approx	On completion of the Graveside Service, Funeral Party and Service personnel Standards and SA Members depart.

9. **Seating Plan.** The Funeral Officer will reserve seating for senior military personnel, Funeral Party and immediate family.

- 10. **Flowers.** The family has requested that flowers only from close relatives are to be sent. Those wishing to make a donation should do so through the Funeral Directors in aid of the Royal Navy Royal Marine Charity and The Marine Society and Sea Cadet Charity. See the Order of Service for further details.
- 11. **Parking.** Parking outside the Sacred Heart Church is extremely limited. Local Police in liaison with Wigan Council will erect no parking cones along Springfield Rd at 0900 on Thu 28 Apr. Springfield Rd is a narrow and busy arterial route, which will be kept clear by police. There are no adjacent public parking areas and it is a dense residential area.
- 12. Changing Facilities. There are no suitable facilities for changing into uniform at Sacred Heart Church.

- 14. **SUMMARY.** Following the tragic circumstances around the death of Lt Cdr Molyneux, the funeral has become an event with major national coverage, as well as generating huge local community interest. Owing to the immense popularity of Lt Cdr Molyneux and the local area support and recognition for the Armed Forces, it is anticipated that the attendance at the funeral will be very significant. I am sure I do not need to point out that this is going to be a very high profile funeral, not only with Senior Officers but with media coverage as well, therefore our dress should be immaculate, standards and equipment polished.
