Quoting from the BIBLE in signals was once a popular form of wit and many officers vied with one another over the number of quotations which they could carry in their heads. It must be admitted that a certain number cheated by keeping theirs in the back of the Fleet Signal Book. In any case no ship ever took part in any exercise without a copy of the Bible on the bridge. Destroyers use to indulge in this form of sport even more than the rest of the fleet. A destroyer C.O. when coming into port mught be interrupted by a shout from the C.O. alongside of who's ship he was going "PROVLEBS 25 - 24", to which the reply might be, "HALF ASTLEN STBD. ISSIAN 56 - 12. HALF AFLAD POLT", to which the first C.O. might reply "2 KINGS & - 19".
